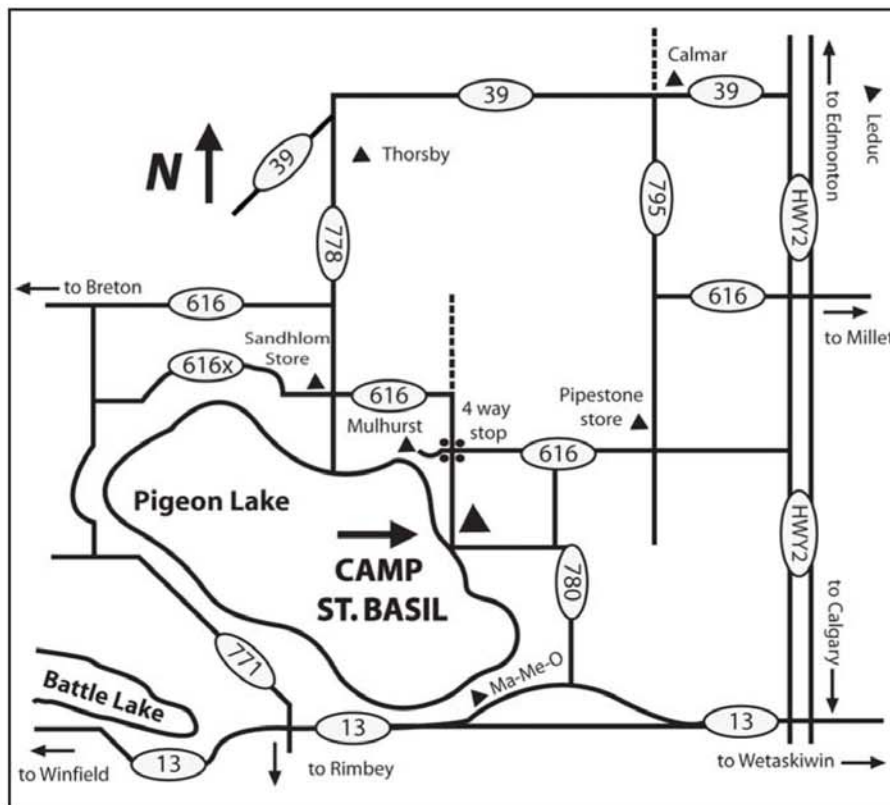

**Check-In:** Sunday, July 3 – 4:00 p.m. (Please do not arrive earlier)  
Sunday, July 10 – 4:00 p.m.

**Check-Out:** Sunday, July 10 – 2:00 p.m.  
Saturday, July 16 – 2:00 p.m.

3:15 p.m. .... Canteen  
6:15 p.m. .... Supper  
7:30 p.m. .... Evening Activity  
9:00 p.m. .... Snack, camp fire and evening prayer  
9:45 p.m. .... Bedtime

**MEDICATION:** All campers’ medicines must be noted on the registration form and turned over to the Camp Nurse upon check-in. Please specify directions for administration of medication on the registration form (eg. when, how often, and how the medication must be taken). If an epi-pen is required then we suggest that two be brought along.

**HEALTH:** Camp St. Basil is subject to Public Health Regulations and Inspections.

**CANTEEN:** As no money is allowed in camp, a “credit” or Canteen is established for every camper at registration time. This amount, which is not to exceed \$12.00/week [\$2.00/Canteen Day] allows the camper to purchase snacks/treats each day Monday to Sunday.

**CAMP T-SHIRT:** Camp St. Basil T-Shirts are available for \$14.00 each. Please specify the size and quantity on the registration form.

**PHONE CALLS:** Approval will only be given to those calls that are of a serious emergency nature and will be restricted to **collect calls** after supper. Calls should be limited to 1 or 2 during the stay. **Letter writing is recommended and encouraged.**

**CAMPERS SHOULD BRING:** Bedding or sleeping bag, pillow, 2 towels, toiletries, 2 pairs of shoes (runners & sandals), watershoes, clothing for at least 7 days (indoor & recreational, for fair or rainy weather), modest bathing suit, hat, sunglasses, insect repellent, sun screen, writing implements, note-book, and reading material. **LABEL EVERYTHING!**

**CAMPERS SHOULD NOT BRING:** iPods, Cell phones, radios, CD/DVD Players or anything electronic. **iPODS and CELLPHONES WILL BE CONFISCATED and held until the end of camp - NO EXCEPTIONS** Other items not to bring matches, lighters, flashlights, knives, valuables or money. Unapproved items maybe confiscated until the end of camp. **The camp will not be responsible for any lost items.**
